DECEMBER 14, 2020

Motion by Merrill, seconded by Toskey to approve the meeting minutes for November 9, 2020. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Tree Ordinance Revisions

City Forester Steve Schumacher brought back the revised Tree Ordinance for a final review before the Commission. Motion by Toskey, seconded by Chevalier to recommend to the City Council for the January 19, 2021 City Council Meeting. Motion carried. The final draft ordinance is attached.

Organics Drop Off Site

City Administrator Neilson updated the Commission on the Organics drop off site to be at the Fire Station parking lot. The startup date is uncertain due to a required text amendment for the City Code relating to fencing around dumpster containers. The County also will enter into a memorandum of understanding with the City for the operation of the site.

Sustainability Plan

Roxy Robertson of WSB presented an outline for the Sustainability Plan for feedback from the Commission. Discussion included incorporating sidewalk and trails into the plan, short and long range goals and action items, and reviewing the partial work completed on the plan by former Commission Member Kimberly Byrd. The Sustainability Plan work will be the focus of the January Commission meeting as well as survey questions relating to sustainability for the City's Community Survey.
