

**MAHTOMEDI CITY COUNCIL  
WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES  
FEBRUARY 20, 2018**

Mayor Jud Marshall convened the City Council work session meeting at 5:30 p.m. with the following Council members in attendance: Richard Brainerd, and Jeff Ledermann. Council member Deans arrived at 6:15 p.m. Also in attendance were Washington County Representatives Kevin Peterson, Corey Slagel, Joe Gustafson, Eric Johnson and County Commissioner Stan Karwoski. Also in attendance were City Administrator Scott Neilson, City Engineer John Sachi, Public Works Director Bob Goebel and Accounting Clerk Jerene Rogers.

**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Council member Brainerd moved, and Council member Ledermann seconded the motion, to approve the agenda as presented.

**DISCUSS COUNTY ROAD 12 STUDY UPDATE**

Washington County Project Engineer Kevin Peterson overviewed the County State Aid Highway 12 Project. He stated the project area is from Wildwood Road/Mahtomedi Avenue to Jamaca Avenue North. He said some of the corridor challenges are poor pavement condition, high parking demands, pedestrian facilities, congestion, etc. He explained the project goals are to improve safety for all users, provide efficient corridor mobility, preserve and enrich the corridor setting, provide a comprehensive transportation network, to be compatible with natural and human environment and financial responsibility. He said there will be a concrete sidewalk along the south side of County Road 12 from the downtown area to Ideal Avenue. He said there will be a center left turn lane added and the median near the Freedom gas station will be removed. The parking on County Road 12 between Warner Road and East Avenue/Hallam Avenue will be eliminated. He said a traffic signal light will be added at County Road 12/East Avenue/Hallam Avenue. He stated that the intersection at County Road 12 and Hilton Trail will be geometrically improved. This should improve the traffic through this intersection.

City Engineer John Sachi said the City will fix some minor valves, hydrants and manholes while the County has the street under construction.

Public Works Director Bob Goebel asked if the City will be a partner with the County for the new traffic signal.

Engineer Peterson said the partnership will be the same as the Hilton Trail signal.

Council member Brainerd asked how the City will fund this project.
