## COVID-19 Procedures for Spring Events

- Waste must be in the trunk, rear of SUV, or cargo bed. If necessary, please reorganize your waste.
- Please stay in your vehicle unless directed to self-unload large electronics.
- Please provide your zip code to the attendant through a cracked window; no driver's license is required.
- Face coverings are required during your visit.
- **Electronics weighing more than 50 pounds must be self-unloaded. See attendant for procedures. If you are unable to self-unload at this event, large electronics are unloaded at the Environmental Center in Woodbury.**



### Hazardous Materials Accepted

**Hazardous materials will be accepted from households only.**

#### Home Improvement:

- Paints, stains, varnishes, & preservatives
- Paint removers & thinners

#### Auto & Recreation:

- Antifreeze
- Motor oil & filters
- Propane tanks

#### Yard & Garden:

- Insect, roach, & ant killers
- Fertilizers & pesticides

#### Household Items:

- Household cleaners
- Aerosol cans
- Fluorescent bulbs (DO NOT TAPE)
- Mercury thermometers & thermostats
- All batteries
- Household sharps - Place in sealed, sturdy container labeled "Household Sharps"
- Vaping devices & e-liquids



### Electronics Accepted

- Computers, monitors & accessories
- TVs, DVD & VCR players
- Phones, cell phones & fax machines
- Microwave ovens

*Remove batteries from all electronic devices & bring separately.*



### Document shredding

Document shredding will also be offered. In order to serve as many people as possible, no more than four boxes per customer will be accepted.

Please note that shredding capacity may be reached before the end of the event.
