**Submit Data & Testing Within 30 Days of Installation**

Testable Devices must be tested and inspected annually. Buildings served by a community public water system must provide notification to the administrative authority and the public water supplier of all testable devices within 30 days of installation.

**Non-Testable Backflow Preventers:**

- Atmospheric Vacuum Breaker
- Anti-siphon Fill Valve
- Vacuum Breaker Wall Hydrant
- Backflow for Carbonated Beverage Dispenser

- Double Check Valve Backflow Prevention Assembly

**What does the device protect:**

**The following plumbing plans must be reviewed by the Minnesota Department of Labor & Industry before a plumbing permit can be issued:**

- ✓ Commercial projects with six or more fixtures (*5 or less fixtures is considered a minor remodel*)
- ✓ Any state licensed facility (i.e. hospital, nursing home, supervised living facility, free-standing outpatient surgical center, correction facility, bldg. care homes/residential hospice & similar state-licensed facilities)(*minor remodel does not apply*)
- ✓ Public buildings owned and paid for by the state or a state agency regardless of cost and school district building projects or charter school building projects (*minor remodel does not apply*)
- ✓ Commercial kitchen or licensed food/beverage preparation, service or processing area (*minor remodel does not apply*)
