Project Update - September 18, 2020

Project Information

This week, the City's contractor finished concrete driveway work and began the restoration work. Next week, the contractor will continue with any remaining restoration work, followed by the installation of concrete fence bases the week of September 28th, and final wear-course paving as early as October 2nd. Please note this schedule is weather dependent, subject to change, and will be updated as necessary. The US Post Office has been notified that mailboxes are back in service, and has been asked to deliver to your mailbox not the temporary mailboxes. Please be patient with this transition, we will do our best to ensure everyone receives their mail at the property.

Information about the scope of improvements, frequently asked questions and project contacts are included in this newsletter. As the project progresses, should you have any questions, please reach out to the contacts listed below. During construction, an on-site representative will be present on site each day who will be your first point of contact and fastest way to get an answer for all questions regarding construction. Newsletters will be delivered or emailed weekly, and posted on the City's website as the project progresses to inform property owners of the progress and upcoming construction schedule.

Construction working hours within the City of Mahtomedi are 7am-7pm during weekdays and 8am-5pm on Saturdays. Work is not permitted on Sundays or holidays.

Doorhangers and Email

During the course of construction, the primary method of communication will be as-needed via doorhanger. Please be sure to check your door each day for a bright-colored doorhanger to alert you to items such as the start of construction, possible water shut downs (in specific locations), temporary mail information (in specific locations), and sod or seed information, etc.

Project Improvements

The 2020 Street Improvements project involves street, trail, storm, and watermain improvements on Birchwood Road and Lost Lake Court.
