CANOE STORAGE RACK RENTAL PROGRAM

Purpose:

The City of Mahtomedi canoe storage rental program provides individuals with canoe storage at three sites within the city park system. A six slot rack is located at Chautauqua Park and Echo Lake and a nine slot rack is located at Mahtomedi Beach.

Policies/Rules:

Application Process

- Applications will be accepted at City Hall on April 1st through April 15th. If April 1st and/or April 15th fall on a weekend, the first business day following the specified date will be used. On April 15th rack assignments will be selected by lot with preference to Mahtomedi residents. After April 15th applications will be accepted on a first come first serve basis.
- The season will begin May 1st and end October 15th of each year.
- An application and rental payment is required for each canoe that will be stored. Only complete applications will be processed.
- A complete application will include the owner's name, street address, home phone number, work phone number, boat license number, make of boat, color of boat, length of boat, proof of ownership (Boat Ownership Card), location preference and completion of a hold harmless agreement.
- Once an application is accepted the applicant has 10 days to provide the rental payment. The payment is for the entire season and will not be pro-rated. Rental space may not be transferred.

Rules:

- Renters will be assigned a storage space, assigned by the City.
- The renter may only store their canoe in the assigned space.
- Boat licenses will be verified to ensure that canoes are in the correct canoe storage rack and space.
- Canoes must be removed by midnight October 15th.
- Renters must be at least 18 years of age.
- Renters must provide their own locking device and chain.
- Canoes stored on racks are to be maintained by owner. The City accepts no responsibility or liability for canoes stored on racks.
- Canoes not removed from their rack by midnight October 15th each year will be removed, at the owner's expense, by the City. A \$100 fee for handling, plus \$5 per day for storage, will be charged for any canoe not retrieved by its owner. All boats removed by the City will be stored outside and will not be covered.
